ArcelorMittal CHOOSES DUNKERQUE-PORT TO EXPORT ITS CONTAINERISED PRODUCTS

Each year, ArcelorMittal Atlantique et Lorraine exports about 5,300 containers from its production sites in northern and eastern France to Asia, America and Africa.

Since 15 June, half of these volumes, especially those destined for India and China, are now managed outbound from Dunkerque instead of Antwerp (*Belgium*).

In recent months, negotiations with all the port stakeholders, and more particularly with the representatives of the shipping lines calling at Dunkerque-Port, had made this logistics choice economically relevant.

The new transport organization also has a positive impact on the environment since it will promote the use of short logistic circuits and gives priority to the use of a mass-scale overland pre-carriage of the cargo.

ArcelorMittal Logistics ensures the transit of the goods for export while the Scheldt Terminal Company (STE) takes care of the packing of the steel coils in the COSCO, OOCL and CMA CGM containers at the Flanders Terminal.

The computer monitoring of each coil throughout the different phases of manufacturing, packaging, packing and shipping, allows ArcelorMittal's end customers (car manufacturers, packaging companies, industry), to follow the preparation and the routing of the products live.

The switchover of other traffic flows (Africa, America) will become effective in a second phase.

"Beyond the positive impact for the environment, we wanted to use a French port for the export of our reels in containers," said Dominique Pair, head of the ArcelorMittal site in Dunkerque. "We have managed to ensure that this choice is economically viable, thanks to the work done with all the economic operators of the port of Dunkerque. The first phase has been launched with 50% of the volumes, and will be continued for other destinations in 2019."
